# Jacob Stalaker Cemetery

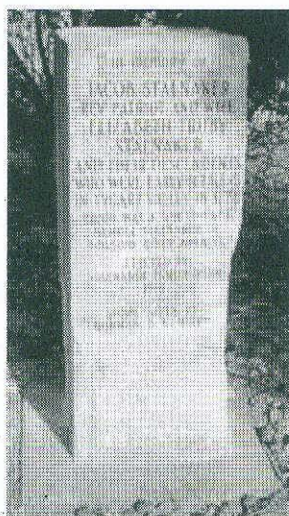


From the south side of Beverly travel 1.7 miles south on US Rt. 219/250 and turn east (left) onto Co. Rt. 37 (Scott Ford Road). Cemetery is at the top of the first veway on the left and to the left of the house. The cemetery can be seen from US RT 219/250.

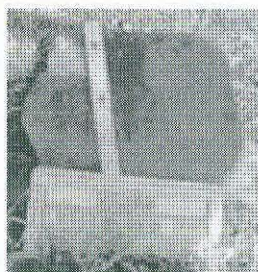

Holston River Area, Va.

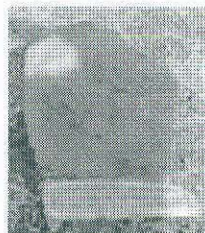

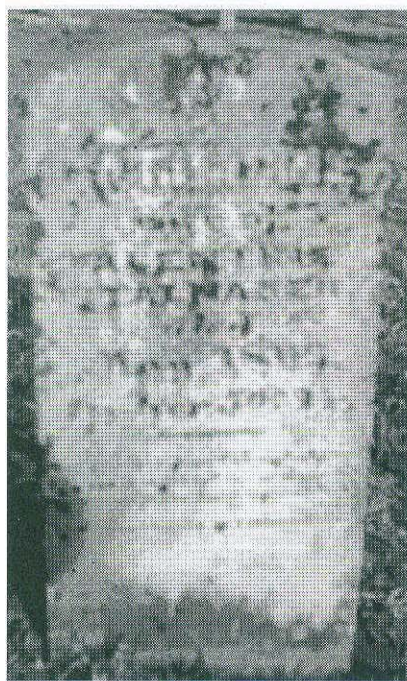




Jacob STALNAKER
