This Indenture made this 26th day of April
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred Return Jacob Stalnaker and Elenor
his wife of the county of Randolph and State of Virginia
of the one part and Jacob Stalnaker of the County
and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth.

That the said Jacob Stalnaker Senr and Elenor his wife, for and in
Consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current money of Vir-
ginia the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted
bargained sold aliened enfeofed and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien enfeof and confirm unto the said
Jacob Stalnaker Junr one certain tract or parcel of land surveyed and
laid off for one hundred acres or it more or less situate in the said
county of Randolph on the south side of Files' Creek and bounded as
followeth, to wit: Beginning at a whit oak on the line that divides
the land of Jacob Westfall and said Stalnaker thence with said line
South thirty nine degrees west one hundred and fifty poles to a whit oak
now fallen and Dogwood, thence North sixty seven degrees west ninety five
poles to Westfall's old line to a green dogwood and dry hickory, thence North
thirty nine degrees East one hundred and eighty six poles passing by a
green Waterbush stump standing on the south bank of Files' Creek and
terminating one pole in the creek thence South forty one degrees west ninety five
poles to the beginning. Together with all profits and Commodities there-
unto belonging or in any wise appertaining with all its appurtenances
to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all its appur-
tenances unto the said Jacob Stalnaker Junr his heirs and assigns
forever and they the said Jacob Stalnaker and Elenor his wife for them-
selves their heirs &c do covenant that they will favour warrant and
defend the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Jacob
Stalnaker Junr his heirs and assigns In Witness whereof the
said Jacob Stalnaker and Elenor his wife hath hereunto set
their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written
