The Last Will & Testament of Jacob Spitzer

In the Name of God Amen. This Last Will & Testament of Jacob Spitzer in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety

of Jacob Spitzer senior of the County of Randolph and Commonwealth of Virginia, being weak in body but perfect in mind and memory, and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed of God for all men Once to die, do therefore make, appoint, ordain, constitute and confirm this my last Will & Testament, And first of all, I recommend my Soul to Almighty God that gave it, and my Body I recommend to be Buried in a Decent and Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter and setting in full assurance that at the grate Day of General Resurrection God will raise it from the Dust and rewrite my Soul and Body and receive them into Glory for Christ's sake. And as touching such worldly Goods and Chattels Property and Estate as I have pleased God to bestow upon me, I give Grant Assign and bestow in the following manner to wit.

First, I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth my Dear & affectional wife, the One Third part of all my Goods Chattels & Estate excepting my Lands to have and to hold the same unto her and her Heirs forever. And I do hereby

affectionate wife the one third part of all my Goods Chattels &  
Estate excepting my Lands to have and to hold the same  
unto her and her personal Heirs And I also grant to my  
said Wife the full life possession and profits and interests of  
all my Lands Buildings and whatsoever appertaineth unto  
them together with the other two third parts of all my other  
Goods Chattels property or Estate during the full term and  
time of her natural life.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Andrew Stain  
after all my Lands Goods and Chattels with every part and  
parcel of my Estate real and personal except the one third of  
the personal Estate as above referred to Elizabeth his mother  
yet with this Condition that the said Elizabeth my wife  
have the full use possession and profits of all said Estate  
until her Decease then the whole to descend to my son  
Andrew and to his Heirs and Heirs in right of Fee firm  
forever And I do hereby constitute my Heirs and well  
beloved friend Matthew Wetton my whole and sole  
Executor of this my last Will and Testament and  
I do hereby revoke my former and make void all former Wills  
I have made and do also hereby Declare among you
